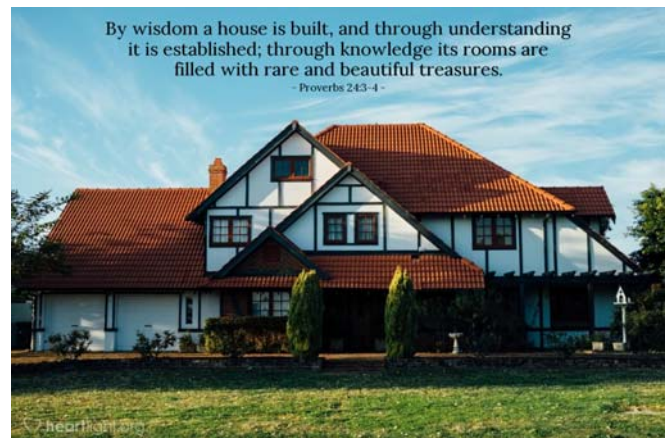


PROVERB FOR THE DAY
